SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION

CRITERIA AND APPLICATION FORM

The Graceville Lions Club is soliciting applications for three scholarships. The scholarships are available to any student who has graduated from Graceville High School or from Poplar Springs High School. Three of the scholarships, the A. Doug Williams Scholarship and the “Daddy Buck” Barker Scholarship, and Wilmer “Slim” Smith Scholarship are administered through the Chipola College Foundation and granted to students attending or planning to attend Chipola. The other, The Graceville Lions Club Scholarship, may be awarded to a graduating senior planning to attend any college or university. The scholarships are available to students planning to attend school in the Fall of 2024. The value or amount of each scholarship will be disclosed in July. The award will be divided equally between the two semesters of the school year and may be used only for books and tuition. Applicants will be interviewed by Lions Club members.

Applications for the scholarships, along with a brief summary of your personal reason for applying for a scholarship, must be submitted by May 1, 2024, to the Graceville Lions Club Scholarship Committee, P O Box 611, Graceville, FL 32440-0611 with the following:

1. High school transcript
2. Achievement test scores
3. Letters of Recommendations
