ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete a Chipola College application online at my.chipola.edu
2. Receive an email verification from Admissions
3. Provide email verification to high school guidance counselor to discuss options
4. Submit
 - a) Official scores on ALL sections of ACT, PERT, or SAT
 - b) Official high school transcript (public, private school) or pupil progression plan (homeschool)
 - c) Minimum qualifying READING Score*
 - d) Minimum unweighted, cumulative high school GPA 3.0 (5 Credits)
5. Receive acceptance email from Chipola with student ID and username/password instructions

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be officially enrolled in a public high school, private school, virtual high school, or home-education program within the Chipola's 5-county district.
2. Must be an eligible student enrolled in grades 6-12 in a Florida public school, private school, or home education program.
3. Must have approval of high school principal or designee.
4. Submit
 - a) Official scores on ALL sections of ACT, PERT, or SAT
 - b) Official high school transcript (public, private school) or pupil progression plan (homeschool)
 - c) Minimum qualifying READING Score*
 - d) Minimum unweighted, cumulative high school GPA 3.0 (5 Credits)

PARTICIPATION STANDARDS

Attendance:

Dual-Enrollment and Early-Admission students attending classes on campus must adhere to the college's and instructors' attendance policies. The only excused absences are those sanctioned by Chipola College. High school activities are not excused absences for dual-enrollment and early-admission students.

Grades:

Must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to remain eligible for the DE/EA program

Withdrawal:

Students must follow their district's withdrawal policy and have approval from their guidance counselor to withdraw from college coursework. Students may not repeat courses in which a W, D, or F is earned until after high school graduation.
