Footnote 2: FSU requires 6 hrs. of international/diversity courses.
Footnote 3: Students must complete 9 hours of coursework ("C" or higher) with any combination of the following prefixes: ACG, CGS, ECO, GEB, MAR, ORI, PET, SPC, and/or STA.
Footnote 4: Students must demonstrate computer literacy with a "C" or better in CGS 1060.
Footnote 5: FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation.
Footnote 6: If student has taken 2 credits of Foreign Language in high school then choose elective.
Footnote 7: FSU requires one Natural Science course with a Lab to be completed before graduation.
Footnote 8: Students enrolled in AA, AS, or BS degree programs must complete the State of Florida's Civic Literacy requirement.
