# Area of Concentration - Accounting

**Prerequisites for Admission: AA or AS degree of 60 or more semester hours, satisfaction of Chipola's general education requirement, completion of ACG 2021, ACG 2071 with a "B" or better, and completion of the following Business Prerequisite Courses with a "C" or better: CGS 1100, , ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 2233, STA 2023 (or STA 2122)**

Students entering this concentration must have completed the Florida **common Business Prerequisites** with a "C" or better (or have consent of department), completed ACG 2021 and 2071 with a "B" or better (or have consent of department), and completed the required 36 semester hours of **general education**. Normally all prerequisites are completed prior to entering the BAS program; any deviation from this must be approved by the Dean of Enrollment services. Students entering the BAS program but lacking any required Business and/or general education courses must complete them at first opportunity; until such courses are completed, these students may only take upper level BAS courses that do not require the uncompleted courses as prerequisites. These prerequisite and general education courses may be included in the 60 hours allocated to the Associate degree courses, but will not be included in the 60 hours of BAS program courses. Hours needed to fulfill the foreign language requirement will not be included in the 60 hours of BAS program courses.
