Area of Concentration - Supervision & Management

Prerequisite for Admission : AA or AS degree of 60 or more semester hours

Students entering this concentration may not have completed the Florida **common Business Prerequisites** and may not have completed the required 36 semester hours of **general education**. Completion of required Business courses and general education should be a priority. Students lacking ENC 1102 must take it at the first opportunity.

ATTENTION!! Students must meet with a business advisor each semester to register for classes.

Core BAS Required Courses listed above (30 Semester Hours)

Required Business and General Education Courses (18 Semester Hours-may be lower level courses)

The sum of the required Business courses, general education courses, and Business elective semester hours must total 18. No more than 18 hours of lower division courses may be counted toward the 60 hours in the BAS degree-S&M. Only lower division courses not previously counted in the 60 hours of the Associate degree may be included here. Hours needed to fulfill the foreign language requirement will not be included here.

Required Business Courses

Students must complete the following Business Prerequisite courses if not completed previously--ECO 2013 or ECO 2023, STA 2023 (or STA 2122). If any of these courses have been previously completed, the hours may be filled by general education hours (if the hours are needed to fulfill Chipola's general education requirements) or by Business electives listed below.

CGS 1100	Microcomputer Applications (Pre: CGS 1060 or test out)
