Admission Requirements for the Teacher Education Degree

1. Associate in Arts degree from a regionally accredited institution or at least 60 semester credit hours of postsecondary education with completion of the general studies requirement.
2. Completion of all lower-division mandated common prerequisites, including the following three Education prerequisites EDF 1005, EDG 2701, EME 2040. See college catalog for freshman and sophomore requirements.
3. Earned overall GPA of 2.5 in lower division coursework.
4. Demonstrated proficiency in state mandated General Knowledge content through satisfactory completion of all four (4) parts of the CLAST examination or the General Knowledge part of the Florida Teachers Certification Exam..
5. Satisfactory background check by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI).
6. Submission of completed Chipola application and official transcripts.
7. Submission of a satisfactory brief narrative that includes a request for admission to the program, factors influencing the applicant's decision to teach, the applicant's philosophy of education, and previous teaching or related experiences which demonstrate the applicant's potential as an educator.
8. Written recommendations from three (3) individuals familiar with the applicant's academic work, personal character, and/or ability to work with the children and/or youth.

*In addition to EDG 2701 and TSL 3080, the Teacher Education Program requires three (3) hours of lower level international/diversity course work. The following Chipola courses meet these requirements: AMH 2091, AMH 2092, FRE 1120, FRE 1121, FRE 2200, FRE 2201, GEA 2001, GEA 2002, REL 2300, SPN 1120, SPN 1121, SPN 2200, SPN 2201, SYG 1010, WOH 2012, and WOH 2022.
