## Exhibit Guidelines

**Eligibility:** The “Sunday Afternoon with the Arts” Exhibit is open to artists 18 years or older, with a mailing address – either work or residence in one of the 5 counties Chipola College serves: Jackson, Washington, Holmes, Calhoun or Liberty County, or a student or alumni in or outside of the regions. Each artist may exhibit up to three pieces of art in any medium. Art must be original – not created from kits or copied from other art and appropriate for audiences of all ages. The exhibit committee reserves the right to determine what is acceptable. The art should be no larger than 50” wide and may not have been previously exhibited at Chipola College Arts Center. No changes to art, titles, etc. will be allowed after entries are submitted. Late entries will not be accepted. There will be no entry fee charged.

**Presentation:** Two-dimensional work must be properly framed, unless it would be best displayed without a frame. Each piece of art must have secure wire on the back for hanging. **NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.** Artwork without frames or proper wiring can not be accepted. Please include a label on the back of each piece with artist’s name, title of work, and medium. If artwork is not for sale, you must state the value on the entry form. Three-dimensional artists who need special display considerations should contact the Exhibit Committee.

**Artist Statement (Optional):** Describe in writing of 50 words or less, what your inspiration / description of our piece of artwork that is being shown. The information will be typed and displayed by your artwork. Please include one for every piece entered.

**Exhibit Opening Reception:** The Opening Reception will be held Sunday, November 1, 2009 from 1:00 – 4:00 PM. All artists are encouraged to attend.

**Delivery and Return of Artwork:** Artist or a representative must hand deliver and pick up their artworks at the times and dates listed in the Exhibit Calendar, unless other arrangements have been made. TAG reserves the right to take possession of artwork that is not picked up for auction purposes.

**Demonstrations:** If you are interested in providing a demonstration or interactive Art experience during the Opening Reception, please contact Michele Tabor Kimbrough at (850) 557-0655 or email: [MTK4Art@embarqmail.com](mailto:MTK4Art@embarqmail.com). Contact her early to reserve your space.

**Sale of Artwork:** Sale of artwork will be handled by each individual artist. All artwork must remain on display for the entire exhibit.

**Publicity:** For purposes of publicity, images of artwork and/or artist may be used unless the artist requests otherwise. Artists, please provide a 1 page Artist Biography with your entry form. Artist Biographies will be placed in a notebook for public viewing during the exhibit and the information may be used for publicity.

**Liability:** Every effort will be made to handle artwork with the best of care; however, Chipola College, CRAA, TAG and volunteers cannot be held responsible for any damage to artwork during the exhibit. Each artist will be required to sign a Hold Harmless Agreement at the time artwork is delivered.
