Old Toad consists of Dr. Stephen Mattingly and Dr. Matthew Cochran, longtime musical collaborators who first met at the Eastman School of Music in 1995. They are co-founders of the groundbreaking Tantalus Quartet with which they regularly appear in concert series and festivals throughout the U.S., Europe and Canada.

Dr. Cochran serves on faculty at Darton College and Albany State University. Dr. Mattingly, a former guitar instructor at Chipola, currently teaches at the University of Louisville.
