

## Chipola Fall Registration begins August 15

Registration for Fall classes at Chipola College begins Wednesday, Aug. 15.

New student testing and registration for returning students is Aug. 15. New and returning student registration is Aug. 16 and 17. Classes begin Aug. 20. State of Florida employees may register Aug. 20-24 using the State Employee Fee Waiver. Late registration will continue through Aug. 24.

Chipola's open-door policy guarantees acceptance to any student with a standard high school diploma. Prospective students should complete a college application which is available in the Office of Admissions and Records, or online at [www.chipola.edu](http://www.chipola.edu). Students also must provide an official high school or college transcript.

Chipola offers day and evening courses, as well as independent study and online courses. The college's Associate in Arts Degree provides the first two years of general education courses for students planning to earn a bachelor's degree. Associate in Science

Degree programs provide two years of professional training in various career fields.

Chipola also awards Bachelor of Science Degrees in Secondary and Middle School Education with majors in Math and Science. A new Bachelor's of Applied Science degree in Business Management is set to begin in January of 2008.

Chipola is offering a number of Workforce Development programs this fall including: Automotive Technology, Computer Systems Technology, Corrections, Cosmetology, Culinary Management, Electronic Technology, Firefighting, Law Enforcement, Nursing Assistant and Welding. Two new workforce programs—Masonry Apprentice Training and Surveying and Mapping Technology—are now accepting students.

Chipola's University Center provides opportunities for students to pursue a number of bachelor's and advanced degrees on the Chipola campus through partnerships with UWF, FSU and Troy.

The five-event series opens Aug. 28 with "A Memorable Musical Soiree," featuring members of Chipola's music faculty. Resident faculty artists—Dr.

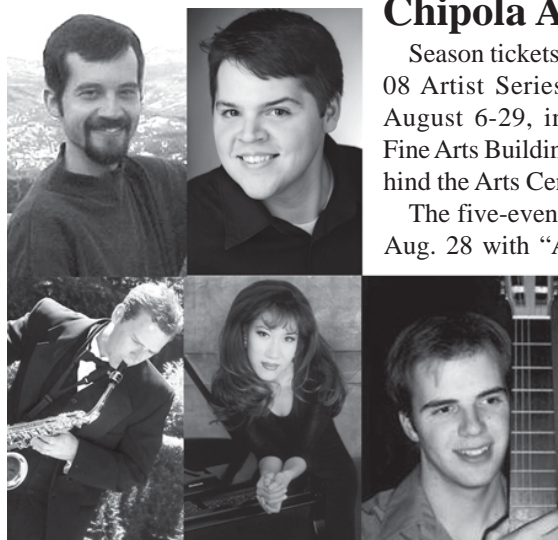
—will delight with their musicianship, skill and showmanship as they present a memorable evening of music from classical to modern.

cal and Modern repertoire in trio and duo combinations for violin/viola, clarinet, and piano.

Proteus 7 will perform March 25. From Bach to Bacharach, Proteus 7 breathes new life into music with their dynamic, creative and free-ranging approach to styles and repertoire. Members of Proteus 7 perform on Broadway and record for television and motion pictures and have been nominated for Emmy and Grammy awards. Their programs are as diverse as their individual talents, balancing intricate works of Baroque masters in tandem with contemporary classical and jazz counterparts, plus everything in between.

The Artist Series is funded through Chipola’s Performing Arts Fund, with grants from the National Endowment for the Arts, the Southern Arts Federation, the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs, the Chipola Regional Arts Association and corporate donors.

Season tickets - \$40 for all five events – entitle holders to same seat reserved seats, invitations to the “Meet The Artist” receptions, subscriptions to the CRAA arts calendar, and early ticket-renewal next year. A limited number of individual event tickets - \$12 for adults and \$8 for ages 18 and under – will be available prior to each performance at the Chipola Business Office.
