Chipola heads to Tallahassee for pair of games

Both Chipola basketball teams head to Tallahassee Community College for a pair of big conference games on Saturday, Jan. 24.

The Indians lead the state and national polls after whipping Pensacola, 84-54, in the conference on Jan. 17. Casey Mitchell led the Indians with 22 points. Justin Brownlee had 15. Jeremy Jacob had 14. Torye Pelham had 9 points and 3 rebounds. Trevor Deloach had 9 points and 6 rebounds. Gary Flowers had 7 points, 10 boards, 8 assists, 5 blocks and 3 steals. Malcolm Armstead had 6 rebounds, 7 assists, and no turnovers.

The defending state champion Indians are 4-0 in league play

and 20-1 overall.

The Lady Indians upset Pensacola, 49-47, in overtime on a last second shot. Latoya Williams led Chipola with 14 points and 9 rebounds. Jamia Akins had 12 points. Ashlie Billingslea had 10 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists. Lenita Sanford had 8 points.

The Lady Indians are 3-1 in conference and 18-3 overall.

Chipola's next home game is Tuesday, Jan. 27, against Gulf Coast Community College. The women's game tips off at 5:30 p.m. The men play at 7:30 p.m.
