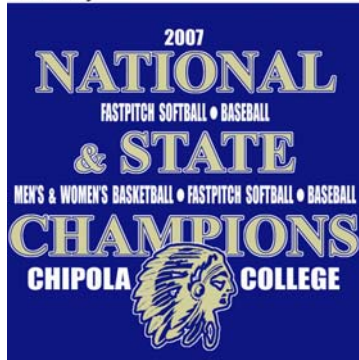


Back side of shirt
