McAllister is Chipola Faculty of the Year

Dr. Gina McAllister is the recipient of the 2006 Faculty/Administrator of the Year Award at Chipola College.

McAllister presently serves as an instructor in Chipola's Teacher Education program in which she teaches a wide range of courses, including Introduction Education, Educational Technology, Teaching Diverse Populations and ESOL—English to Speakers of other Languages.

McAllister recently was selected to represent the faculty on a college-wide Quality Enhancement Plan which is part of a re-accrreditation program for the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS).

She also has represented the faculty on a number of college committees including Staff and Program Development; Computing and Telecommunication; and Catalog and Class Schedule.

McAllister is a member of the American Educational Research Association. She also holds membership in four college organiza-

tions: Applauding Chipola Theatre; Florida Association of Community Colleges, Council of Chipola Educators and the Chipola Appreciation Club.



The Faculty/Administrator of the Year award provides a \$1,000 bonus, and a \$100 gift certificate from the College Book Store reserved parking for a year. The award is selected from among the monthly winners.
