Chipola players picked in Major League Draft

Six members of the 2004-05 Chipola College baseball team were picked in the Major League Baseball Draft last week.

Sophomore All-American infielder **Matt Gamel** was picked by the Milwaukee Brewers in the fourth round of the Major League Baseball Draft on June 7. Gamel is reportedly at a camp in Helena, Montana.

Sophomore **Daniel Roberts** was drafted in the 13th round by Arizona Diamondbacks. He is expected to play college ball at Louisiana-Monroe next year.

Four other players from Chipola's 2004-05 squad were drafted but are expected to play their sophomore year at Chipola.

Freshman **Clay Long** was picked by 43rd round by the Cincinnati Reds. The Anaheim Angels selected freshman **Stephen Brock** in the 14th round in a draft and follow deal. Freshman catcher **Tyler Flowers** was picked by the Atlanta Braves in the 33rd round. Freshman **Rene Tosoni** was selected in the 36th round by the Minnesota Twins. Coach Jeff Johnson said, "We're looking forward to having

these draft picks and a few other guys returning from last year's team. It will be great to have some experienced players on the squad," Johnson said.

Former Chipola player **Alan Horne** of Marianna was picked in the 11th round by the New York Yankees. Horne started his college career at Ole Miss in 2001 before playing a year at Chipola in 2004 and then transferring to the University of Florida this season. Horne helped lead the Gators to the college World Series which begins June 17.

Five other Chipola players are making their way through the professional ranks. **Russell Martin** is playing AA ball for the Jacksonville Suns an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. **Jose Bautista** is playing for an affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. **Ricardo Nanita** is in the White Sox A league. **Adam Loewen** is with the Baltimore Orioles A squad in Maryland. **Blake Balkcom** of Chipley is playing for the Rancho Cucamongo Quakes associated with the Anaheim Angels.

Chipola seeks applications for EMT

Chipola College is now accepting applications for an upcoming Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training program.

The EMT program prepares students for employment as ambulance drivers/ambulance attendants, or emergency medical technicians and to treat various medical/trauma conditions.

The curriculum includes simulated learning and clinical study. The 11 credit-hour course is 250 clock-hours in length. Cost is approximately \$1,000 for tuition, insurance, books and uniforms. EVOC (Emergency Vehicle Operation) is not included in the course. Clinical assignments are required in addition to regular class hours.

Prerequisites for the EMT Program include: high school diploma or GED with grade point average; Certification in American Heart CPR Level C Healthcare Provider; FDLE Background check; and satisfactory score on the college placement test reading subtest.

Prospective students must undergo a Physical Examination including drug screen and TB skin test.

Compliance with the prerequisites does not guarantee acceptance. The class is limited to 24 students. Those with the highest GPA's will be selected. If college courses were taken, the college level GPA will be used in place of the high school GPA.

Application deadline is July 20. Candidate interviews are scheduled for July 26. Classes begin Aug. 2. The class will meet Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6 to 10 p.m. with some weekend classes.
