Kelly Lichtfuss, a star of the Marianna High School softball program, has signed a scholarship with Chipola College.

Lichtfuss originally signed with Alabama Southern, but decided to stay closer to home for the next two seasons.

New Chipola softball coach Belinda Hendrix said, "Kelly has tremendous composure, especially at third base. She's also a great hitter and a tremendous all-around athlete."

Lichtfuss was a four year starter for the Lady Bulldogs with honors including All-Big Bend, co-MVP, co-captain of the 2003 squad and two-time Lady Bulldog Award winner for effort and attitude. She is also a three time winner of the Gatorade Will-to-Win Athlete Award.

Lichtfuss led Marianna in RBI's and logged a .444 batting average. She helped lead the Lady Dogs to a 2001 district championship and runner-up in district in the 2002 and 2003 seasons.

In addition to high school softball, Lichtfuss is a member of the Shogun travel softball team coached by Jeff Strode.
