Application deadline for Summer Session II at Chipola College is June 10. Registration is Tuesday, June 22. Classes begin Wednesday, June 23. Recent high school graduates and other students who enroll in Summer II classes earn the right to register early for Fall classes.

Chipola's open-door policy guarantees acceptance to any student with a standard high school diploma. Prospective students should complete a college application which is available in the Office of Admissions and Records located in Room 112 in Building L, or online at www.chipola.edu. Students also must provide an official high school or college transcript.
