Hendrix named Chipola softball coach

New Chipola College softball coach Belinda Hendrix was introduced at a press conference Tuesday, May 25.

Chipola president Dr. Gene Prough said, "We are proud to welcome coach Hendrix to the Chipola family. She respects the great traditions established here at Chipola and she is committed to the success of our student-athletes."

Hendrix said, "I'm very excited to be here at Chipola. I look forward to building a respectable softball program and helping my girls to become great scholars and players."

The 28 year-old Hendrix comes to Chipola from Vernon High School where she has coached girls' softball since 2001. She led Vernon to an overall record of 56-22 in three seasons. During the 2004 season, the Lady Yellow Jackets won the district champion-

ship and made it to the regional semi-finals. All six seniors on Hendrix's 2003 Vernon team were offered college scholarships. Vernon captured a district championship and advanced to the regional quarterfinals in 2002.

Hendrix played college softball at Thomas University in Thomasville, GA, where she was named to the All-Regional team. She earned a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Troy State University at Dothan. Hendrix is a 1994 graduate of Chattahoochee High School where she led her softball team to a district championship and was named MVP.

Hendrix is married to Jimmy Hendrix, the boys' baseball coach at Vernon High. The couple has two children: Madyson, 4, and Jade, 8 months.

Hendrix replaces former Chipola softball coach Sharon Coleman who resigned this month after seven seasons at the helm of the Lady Indians' program.

Application deadline for Summer Session II at Chipola College is June 10. Registration is Tuesday, June 22. Classes begin June 23. Recent high school graduates and other students who enroll in Summer II classes earn the right to register early for Fall classes.

Chipola's open-door policy guarantees acceptance to any student with a standard high school diploma. Prospective students should complete a college application which is available in the Office of Admissions and Records located in Room 112 in Building L, or online at www.chipola.edu. Students also must provide an official high school or college transcript.
