## Chipola students perform well on CLAST

Chipola students have proven by at least one measure that they are well-prepared to transfer to a university.

According to a report from the Florida Department of Education, Chipola students placed third among Florida's 28 community colleges and 10 state universities in the percentage of students passing all four subtests of the October administration of the CLAST (College Level Academic Skills Test).

CJC's percentage of students passing all four subtests was 54, compared to 40 for state universities, 29 for the community colleges and 34 for the state as a whole. Chipola also outperformed the six community colleges and three universities in the Panhandle Region in overall passing rate.

Chipola was fourth among the community colleges on the Essay Subtest, with an 89 percent passing rate, compared to the university passing rate of 86, the community college rate of 84, and the statewide rate of 85.

Chipola also was ranked fifth among community colleges on the Reading Subtest, with a mean score of 307, compared to the university mean of 305, the community college mean of 299 and the statewide mean of 305. Chipola ranked sixth among community colleges on the English and Language Skills Subtest.

CLAST is the statewide exam that all college sophomores in Florida must pass in order to enter the junior level at a state university.

## Lady Indians at home Tuesday

The Chipola Lady Indians host the final home basketball game of 2000 in their Tuesday, Dec. 12 matchup with Wallace @ Hanceville.

The Lady Indians are 6-4 on the year after picking up three out of four recent road games. Chipola fell to Santa Fe 80-72 on Dec. 5. Chipola was led by Satoya Spates with 13. D'Leisha Cockerham had 13. Sowo Varney added 14.

Chipola's women whipped Faulkner 81-61 in the Wallace@Hanceville Classic Dec. 2. Spates led with 15. Cockerham scored 13. The Lady Indians scored a 76-62 win over Wallace@Hanceville on Dec. 1. Spates led with 25 points. Varney had 10. Barnes logged 11 rebounds, six steals and four assists. CJC whipped Darton 82-73 on Nov. 30 82-73. Spates led with 23. Collins had 22 points and 9 rebounds. Tasha Mathis added 18.

The third-ranked Chipola Indians swept a trio of home games last weekend. Chipola crushed 98-54 Manatee CC on Nov. 30 behind Janerio Spurlock's 25 points. Lavelle Felton scored 15 points and grabbed 5 rebounds. Wayne Bransom added 11 points and 6 rebounds.

In the Ramada Limited Classic Dec. 1, CJC whipped FCCJ 101-84. Spurlock led all scorers

with 27 points and six grabs. Michael Wilder scored 20 points and pulled in six rebounds. Felton had 13 points, 11 rebounds and five assists. Kareem Johnson scored 10 points and pulled in 13 rebounds. Wayne Bransom had 10 points and 11 rebounds. Troyce Haynesworth scored 10.

The Indians scored a decisive 109-85 win over Abraham-Baldwin Dec. 2. Wilder had 29 points and 8 rebounds. Spurlock scored 19 points and five assists. Johnson had 15 points and 13 rebounds. Bransom had 13 points and nine rebounds. Felton had 13 points and 5 assists. John Andrews had 10 points and 10 rebounds.

The Indians are currently ranked third in the state and 26<sup>th</sup> in the national poll with a 10-2 record. Winning the Panhandle Conference is looking to be as tough as winning the national tournament with Okaloosa-Walton ranked first in the state and second in the nation. Tallahassee is second in the state and 12<sup>th</sup> in the nation.

The Indians travel to Bradenton Dec. 7 for games with Manatee, Seminole and Miami Dade. CJC closes out the fall season with a Dec. 16 game at St. John's River CC.

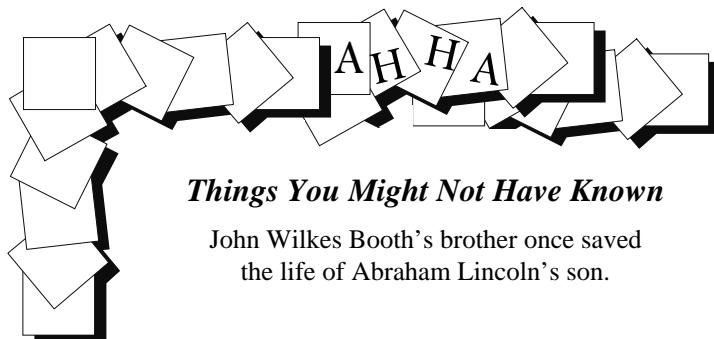
