Chipola hires Broadway director for Fall show

In a special agreement signed July 6, Chipola has secured the professional services of Broadway director/producer and Marianna native Larry Alford to present a Fall '98 musical theatre gala in association with Alford's new Florida-based company, *SouthernStuff*.

The official announcement by CJC President Dr. H. Dale O'Daniel was a result of a month of Alford's talks with O'Daniel; Dr. Sarah Clemmons, Dean of Arts, Business, Letters and Library; and Joan Stadskev, Director of Fine and Performing Arts. President O'Daniel says, "We are excited about bringing a producer/director of Larry Alford's caliber to Chipola. He has built an exceptional reputation in professional theatre, and we are proud to count him among CJC's most outstanding graduates."



Currently in town to work on the CJC production and several other *SouthernStuff* projects in development, Alford now shares time among his New York and Florida homes and businesses.

"I'm thrilled the timing was right for me to return to produce a show in Marianna," Alford said. "The college and community have a special place in my heart and, with everyone's support, I look forward to presenting a top-quality production here using both celebrity and area talent."

Specific show and ticket information will be announced before September 1.

With degrees from Florida State University, the University of West Florida and Chipola, Alford returned home to Marianna in the early 1970's as CJC's Director of Theatre. After seven

years and over 25 productions, he moved to New York City to open his entertainment company, *Alford Productions*, and begin building over two decades of prestigious professional credits.

Alford co-created and directed the Broadway musical, "Jerry's Girls" starring Chita Rivera and Leslie Uggams, that featured showtunes from composer Jerry Herman's hits, including "Hello, Dolly!," "Mame," and "La Cage aux Folles." He served in the same creative capacities for the Carol Channing national tour, acclaimed international productions, and the Off-Broadway version of "Jerry's Girls" that the New York Times called "brilliant and scintillating."

He has also produced and directed shows starring Gloria Estefan, Roberta Flack, Joel Grey, Hal Linden, Mary Martin, Mary Tyler

Moore, Rita Moreno, Elizabeth Taylor, Tommy Tune, Barbara Walters and many others. From his extensive catalog of musical revues, Alford also presents shows in New York, on tour in America and abroad, at celebrity gala benefits, for corporate events and on luxury cruise ships. The Larry Alford Entertainers perform around the world in musical shows like "Jukebox Boogie," "Going Hollywood" and "Country Clubbin'."

In March Alford's *Southern Stuff* premiered "Broadway Ballyhoo!" starring long-time friend Jo Anne Worley at the Martin Theatre in Panama City, with area critics praising the show as "stellar," "dazzling," and "incredible." Among those attending were many area residents, including current and former Chipola faculty, staff and students.
