## New course offerings at Chipola

### Chipola offering freshman English online

The Chipola Junior College Arts and Letters Department is now offering Communications Skills I (ENC 1101) in an online format.

Students and instructor interact via internet, meeting only once every two weeks at the college. A chat room, a CD-ROM, and e-mail replace most of the instructor's classroom lectures and group discussions. Typed essays may be e-mailed to the instructor.

This web-based course allows students the opportunity to earn four credit hours in ENC 1101 without meeting in a classroom, four times per week for sixteen weeks. Dr. Laurie Culbreth, a CJC English

instructor will teach the course. Online students must possess computer/internet skills and should be able to manage effectively their academic, personal, and/or professional schedules.

Regular registration for the fall term is August 17 and 20. Persons interested in the course must register on the CJC campus before logging in and registering with the instructor. Online students also must attend a distance-learning orientation meeting Aug. 23 at 5 p.m., in Building D-300.

### CJC Auto Program gets new computer

The Chipola Junior College Automotive Technology program recently received a new Genisys Automotive Hand Held Vehicle Diagnostic computer donated by OTC/SPX corporation of Owotonna, MN.

CJC auto tech instructor John Gardner, says, "With the help of our advisory board and local tool representatives we were able to acquire this state of the art scan tool." The computer, valued at \$4,000, represents the next generation of information system in the automotive industry. The Genisys comes complete with 20 years of diagnostic coverage, scan, diagnostic capabilities along with scope, meter, reflash

and five gas features. It also has network capabilities along with vehicle updates downloaded via the Internet. Gardner says, "This donation will afford our students as well as local technicians the opportunity to work with the latest technology available."

Gardner is currently writing the training curriculum for the new scan tool. He says, "The scan tool will enhance our already updated program and help us achieve national certification. The Genisys will be incorporated into the curriculum immediately which will benefit our students and local industry."

Dr. Carolyn E. Poole, director of Library Services at CJC, has had a research manuscript accepted for publication in *College & Research Libraries (C&RL)*, a journal of the Association of College and Research Libraries division of the American Library Association.

Her paper entitled, "Technological Change in the Workplace: A State-wide Survey of Community College Library and Learning Resources Personnel," will appear as the lead article in the November 2001 issue.

The purpose of the investigation was to examine how those employed in Florida community college libraries are handling "technostress" and change in their work environment. She and co-author Emmett Denny (TCC) found that community college library personnel are generally reacting positively to change.

Dr. Poole is the first Florida community college library director to be published in this journal.

## CJC new student application deadline is August 9

New students planning to enroll at Chipola Junior College in the Fall of 2001 are encouraged to complete the application process prior to the **Aug. 9 deadline**.

Registration for the Fall semester is **Aug. 16** for current students, and **Aug. 17 and 20** for new students. **Fall classes begin Aug. 21**. Late registration will continue through Aug. 27.

Chipola's open-door policy guarantees acceptance to any student with a high school diploma. Applying consists of three easy steps. First, complete an application—available in the Registration Office. Second, provide an official high school or college transcript. And third, provide proof of measles immunization. Once these steps are completed, accepted students will be assigned an advisor who will provide assistance with registration. Chipola offers hundreds of college credit courses

leading to the Associate in Arts Degree. The AA guarantees acceptance to the junior year at Florida's ten public universities. Courses are available during the day and evening, and also through independent study.

Chipola's Workforce Development Division offers Associate in Science and Certificate programs which feature open enrollment and self-paced learning. Most Workforce programs offer excellent job placement potential.


The University Center @ Chipola provides opportunities for students to pursue a number of bachelor's and advanced degree programs on the CJC campus.
