## Kids' College begins June 1

There are still plenty of openings for the first session of Kids' College at Chipola which runs June 1-June 10. Teen College will also run June 1-June 10.

The second session of Kids' College is June 21-July 1 (Session II). Both sessions have morning camps from 9 a.m. to Noon and afternoon camps from 1-4 p.m.

Kids' College offers six morning camps: Camping/Hiking; Computer Camp; Performing Arts Camp; Science Camp; Sports Camp; and Swim, Sun and Safety Camp. Students may choose two from the following afternoon classes: Animal Balloons/Clown Make-up and Face Painting; Around the World in Eight Days; Art; Baseball Cards and Chess; Christmas in June and July; Clay Creations and Origami; Computers/Introduction; The Internet; Country Line Dancing; Crafty Creations; Jazz; Jewelry Making; Kids in the Kitchen; Let's Play Ball; Magic;



Memory Makers; Miss Manners; Music in Motion; Rocketry I; Rocketry II; T-shirt Magic; Treasure Hunt on Pirate's Cove; Whodunnit?; Zig Zag and Pop-up Books.

Early and late classes are available for parents who wish to drop their kids off as early as 7 a.m. or pick them up as late as 5:30 p.m. Ages 7-12 are welcome. The cost is \$50 and up.

Teen College—a new program for kids ages 13-15—will be offered June 1-June 10, from 9 a.m. to Noon and from 1-4 p.m. Teens may choose one of three morning camps: Computers, Performing Arts and Sports. Afternoon participants may choose two of eight camps: Babysitting 101;

Baseball Cards/Chess; Country Line Dancing; Exercise/Weight Training; The Finishing Touch; Let's Play Ball; Rocketry I and Where Did My Money Go? The cost is \$50 and up.
