### CJC to host Ramada Limited Thanksgiving Classic

Chipola will host the Ramada Limited Thanksgiving Classic on Nov. 27 and 28 in the Johnson Health Center.

Classic action tips off on Thursday, at 3:30 p.m., with Delgado women against Miami-Dade. Friday, at 1:30 p.m., with Delgado women against Gulf Coast. **The CJC Lady Indians play Miami-Dade at 3:30 p.m.** At 5:30 p.m., Polk Community College's men face Wallace Community College. **Chipola's men take on St. Johns River Community College in the Friday feature game at 7:30 p.m.**

Classic action continues on Saturday, Nov. 28, with Miami-Dade's women facing Gulf Coast. Chipola's women meet Delgado at 3:30 p.m. At 5:30 p.m., Wallace College's men play St. Johns River. **Chipola's men play Polk in Saturday's feature game at 7:30 p.m.**

**The Indians split a pair of games at the Best Western Classic on Nov. 13 and 14 at CJC. Chipola's men lost a defensive battle with Holmes Community College 51-48 on Friday. CJC led most of the first half, but turnovers and missed free throws cost the Indians the game. Randy Hughes was CJC's leading scorer with 12. Clyde Ellis had 10.**

The Indians rebounded with a win over the FCCJ (Jacksonville) Stars 97-79 on Saturday. The win avenged the Indians' Nov. 9 loss to the Stars. Michael Hardaway led Chipola with 25 points. Dennis Cannon had 18, Hughes, 17, and Marcell Davis, 12. CJC coach Carl Nash says, "This is a great win for us. We put together two pretty good halves. We can build on this win." Chipola travelled to the Southeastern JUCO Shootout on Nov. 20-21 in Daytona Beach. The Indians are 3-2 as of Nov. 19.

In women's action, the CJC Lady Indians beat Darton College 81-63 on Friday. Chipola's women suffered their first loss of the season to Daytona on Saturday, 57-55. Angela Thornton led Chipola in the Classic with a total of 22 points and 18 rebounds. The Lady Indians opened the season with a 62-48 win over L.B. Wallace on Nov. 9. Freshman Keelee Traylor led Chipola with 12 points and 10 rebounds. The Lady Indians are 2-1 as of Nov. 18.

The Lady Indians played FCCJ on Nov. 19, in the Tallahassee Leon County Civic Center, in a preview game before the FSU Lady Seminoles' game. For information, call the Athletic Department at 718-2302.
