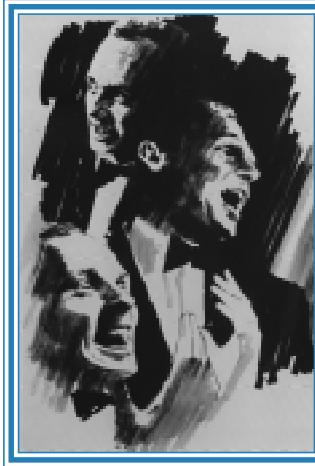

## CJC student named to state articulation committee

CJC sophomore James Joseph (J.J.) Johnson of Chipley was recently appointed by Florida Education Commissioner Frank Brogan to serve on the statewide Articulation Coordinating Committee.

The Committee's purpose is to review and recommend policy relating to Florida's Articulation Agreement that governs student transfer from one system to another. Johnson will serve as a member of each of five Standing Committees that report to the Coordinating Committee. The committee was established in 1971 to adjudicate institutional or student conflicts regarding transfer and admissions, interpret and recommend

amendments to the Articulation Agreement, and develop procedures to facilitate articulation.

Commissioner Brogan said, in a letter to Johnson, "I know that you are well aware of the need for effective communication among the different entities and levels of education in this state, and thus the importance of the Articulation Coordinating Committee."

Johnson is the only student among 13 committee members representing all levels of education: the State University System, the community college system, workforce education and public schools.
