Yuletide Celebration Scheduled at Chipola

The Christmas portion of Handel's beloved oratorio "Messiah" will be performed as a community sing-along as part of Chipola Junior College's Yuletide Celebration on Sunday, Dec. 6.

The event begins at 2 p.m. in the CJC Arts Center, and will feature other Christmas favorites performed by the college's Chamber Chorus, Show Choir and Jazz Ensemble.

In the tradition of hundreds of communities around the world, Chipola will celebrate "Messiah" with this sing along performance. Area singers are invited to sing this time-honored treasure, and are requested to attend a rehearsal on Saturday, Dec. 5 from 12 Noon to 2 p.m. in the Arts Center. A chorus and orchestra of regional

musicians will usher in this holiday season under the batons of CJC music faculty Dr. Ed Lyon and Dr. Allen Molineux.

According to Joan Stadskev, director of CJC's Fine and Performing Arts, "There's something for everyone. It is an afternoon of musical enjoyment and celebration. This is Chipola's gift to the area we serve, and admission is free."

"Messiah" was written by Handel in 1741. He completed the work in the incredibly short space of 24 days—one of the greatest feats in the history of musical composition. Upon the completion of the "Hallelujah Chorus" his servant found him with tears streaming from his eyes. History records Handel as stating, "I did think I did see all of Heaven before me, and the Great
