## Summer childrens' programs at CJC

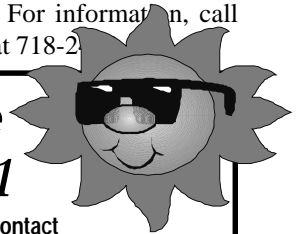
The summer vacation is nearly half over, but there are still plenty of opportunities for young people in summer programs at Chipola Junior College.

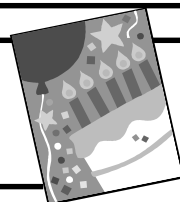

The University Center @ Chipola Junior College and the University of West Florida will host an Open House Monday, June 18, from 4 to 6 p.m., in CJC Building L, Room 402.

The Open House is for students interested in the UWF Bachelor of Arts degree in Special/Elementary Education. UWF and CJC have collaborated to offer this 2+2 program. Students complete the first half of a four-year degree as Chipola students and the last half as UWF students. UWF faculty teach the classes on Chipola's campus in the afternoons and evenings. UWF awards the degrees.

Chipola Junior College will offer a variety of short courses during the months of June and July.

**Work Zone Traffic Control Advanced Training** will meet June 22 and 23, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The course is required for engineers responsible for work zone traffic control plan development, professional engineers responsible for signing and sealing plans, and/or the work zone traffic control supervisor. Cost is \$350.

An **Internet** class will meet June 25 and 26 from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m. Cost is \$45.

An **Early Childhood Internship** will be offered each Monday and Wednesday June 25 through August 7, from 6 to 9:20 p.m. Cost is \$98.

An **IV Therapy** course for LPN's and RN's will be held June 25-28, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Cost of the 30-hour course is \$60.

A **First Aid** class will meet June 27 and 28 from 5 to 9:30 p.m. Cost is \$40.

UWF and CJC personnel will be available at the open house to provide program and financial aid information, academic counseling, assistance with the application and registration processes and any questions about this program. 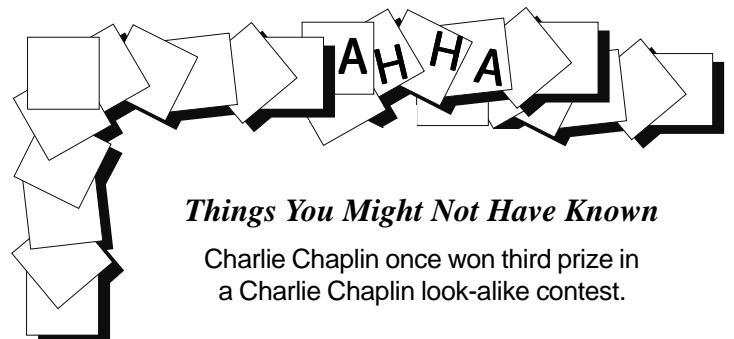
