

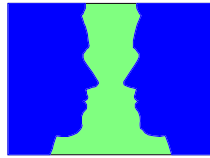
This Associate of Arts degree program is designed for students who expect to transfer and earn a degree in Communication Sciences & Disorders at the University of Florida.

Entrance Requirements

A minimum overall GPA of 2.8 is required for admission, with a minimum GPA of 2.75 in tracking courses. *Do not begin this program unless you are planning to complete a master's degree.* To be certified as a Speech/Language Pathologist or Audiologist, you must earn a master's degree from an accredited program. This program is in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

The University of Florida will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language requirement.
