### Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum composite score of 20 on the Enhanced ACT and a minimum GPA of 2.5 are required for admission to the College of Education. A strong academic preparation is a must! March 15 is the application deadline; everything must be on file at FSU by this date, not in the mail!

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.

**FSU will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language requirement.**

Applicants are chosen based on GPA, ACT/SAT scores, relevant experience, and professional promise. Contact FSU College of Education, 115 Stone Bldg., for a complete application packet.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they may also be fingerprinted before student teaching in certain counties.
