### Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for admission into the College of Education.

TSUD requires a Senior Exit Exam (SEE). The exam includes tests in the liberal studies and in the major. If the CLAST is taken and passed at CJC, students will be exempted from the general studies portion of the SEE. If the CLAST is exempted at CJC, students will be required to take the general studies portion of the SEE at TSUD before the bachelor's degree is awarded. To graduate with honors, all attempts on all courses are included in the GPA calculation.

For admissions purposes, TSUD calculates GPA on all attempts including W (withdrawal) grades. For graduation purposes, TSUD calculates GPA based on the last attempt.
