Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. A minimum of 50 hours of work experience (either voluntary or paid) in an Occupational Therapy setting is required. Application deadline is February 15 for the following fall term.

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
