Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

This program only admits students in the fall semester, February 1 is the application deadline, and a minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for consideration.

A course in African-American History is required to graduate from FAMU. Consider taking AMH 2091 at CJC before transfer.

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
