

This Associate of Arts degree program has been designed for students who plan to transfer to the College of Allied Health and earn a degree in Respiratory Therapy at Florida A & M University.

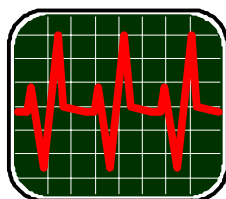

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for admission; check with FAMU for application deadline. As a part of the application process, students must complete a specific number of hours of volunteer work/observation at designated health care facilities. Students must arrange this observation through the department at FAMU during their enrollment at CJC. Contact FAMU, School of Allied Health, Cardiopulmonary Science, to complete this process.

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
