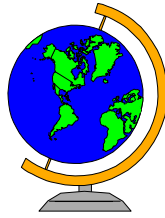

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum composite score of 20 on the Enhanced ACT and a minimum GPA of 2.5 are required for admission to the College of Education.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. Students may take CGS 1060 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they may also be fingerprinted before student teaching in certain counties.
