

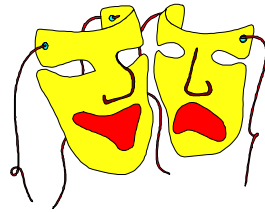

### Entrance Requirements

A GPA of 2.7 is required for admission.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT. An additional 4 hours of foreign language at the sophomore level will be required for graduation from FSU.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. Students may take CGS 1060 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.
