## Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 2.8 is required for admission. Generally admission is for the fall semester only; exceptions require approval from the Department Chairperson. If you plan to pursue public school teacher preparation, you must be formally admitted to teacher education. The following courses, along with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and passing scores on all parts of CLAST will meet the College of Education requirements. **April 1 is the application deadline; all information must be on file at FSU by the deadline—not in the mail!**

**FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT.**

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. CGS 1060 or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

**A master's degree is required for certification and licensure in either audiology or speech pathology; students should plan to continue in a graduate program.**
