Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum composite score of 20 on the Enhanced ACT, a minimum GPA of 2.5, passing scores on all parts of the CLAST, and completion of Gordon Rule requirements are required for admission to the College of Education.

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
