Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. All entering music majors are required to take a placement audition in applied music. Students are expected to be prepared to play or sing representative works. A minimum 2.5 GPA, and passing scores on all parts of the CLAST are required for admission to the College of Education.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. CGS 1060 or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they may also be fingerprinted before student teaching in certain counties.
