Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 2.8 overall and in all pre-professional course work is required for consideration. The nursing department application and all supporting materials must be RECEIVED by UF before February 1. All coursework must be completed by the end of the summer I semester prior to the anticipated fall registration (no more than two courses can be in progress during this term). The Allied Health Professions Admissions Test (AHPAT) is also required (call 1-800-622-3231 for information); must be submitted with application.
