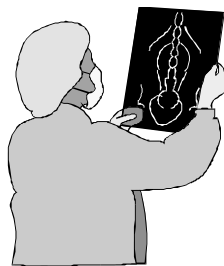

It is the only four-year degree program in Radiologic Sciences at a state university in Florida.

The primary role of the radiographer is to perform medical imaging procedures and diagnose disease and injuries. Radiation therapists work closely with physicians to deliver high-energy radiation for the treatment of cancer. Graduates are eligible to take the national registered technologist certification examination. Positions include radiographer and radiation therapist in hospitals, clinics, and physicians' offices.

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program. March 1 application deadline.
