

This Associate in Arts degree program includes courses required for those students who expect to transfer and earn a degree in the College of Agriculture at the University of Florida, which has approximately 21 majors and over 37 specializations.

The course requirements for the first two years are very similar for all programs. GPA requirements vary depending on specific major.

Possible career options in agriculture include high school ag or biology teacher, county agent, ag equipment sales, ag engineering, environmental systems manager, land and water manager, forest resource manager, horticulturist, wildlife manager, and pre-professional preparation for the colleges of medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, and veterinary sciences.
