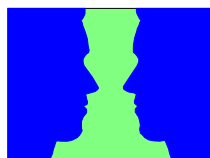

### Entrance Requirements

A minimum overall GPA of 2.8 is required for admission, with a minimum GPA of 2.75 in tracking courses. *Do not begin this program unless you are planning to complete a master's degree.* To be certified as a Speech/Language Pathologist or Audiologist, you must earn a master's degree from an accredited program. This program is in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.

**The University of Florida will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language requirement.**
