## Entrance Requirements

**This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.**

A 3.0 minimum overall GPA, minimum grades of "B" in required core courses, a minimum of 100 documented clock hours of experience with a licensed athletic trainer, and consent of the Program Director are required for admission. **Check with the UCF department for application deadlines.**

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
