### Entrance Requirements

TSUD requires a Senior Exit Exam (SEE). The exam includes tests in the liberal studies and in the major. If the CLAST is taken and passed at Chipola, students will be exempted from the general studies portion of the SEE. If the CLAST is exempted at Chipola, students will be required to take the general studies portion of the SEE at TSUD before the bachelor's degree is awarded. To graduate with honors, all attempts on all courses are included in the GPA calculation.

For admissions purposes TSUD calculates GPA on all attempts (grades of W are not included for this major). For graduation purposes, TSUD calculates GPA based on the last attempt.
