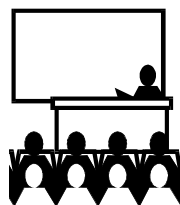

### Entrance Requirements

A minimum GPA of 2.5 and passing scores on all parts of CLAST are required for admission to the College of Education. Student teaching GPA requirements are higher.
