Health Information Managers are professional members of the modern health care team responsible for the acquisition and supervision of complete medical records on each patient; the design and management of health information systems which collect, process, store, retrieve, and release health information and statistics; assistance to administration, other health professionals, and medical staff in developing quality assurance programs by abstraction of medical data, preparation of statistical reports, and analysis of information; and assistance in collection and analysis of data for public health services planning.
