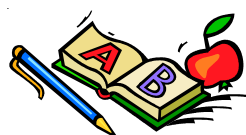
This Associate in Arts degree program is designed for students who expect to transfer and earn a degree to teach pre-kindergarten through third grade.

### Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 2.5 and passing scores on all parts of CLAST or on the general knowledge section of FTCE are required for admission to the College of Education. A strong academic preparation is a must! March 15 is the application deadline; everything must be on file at FSU by this date, not in the mail! Students are admitted in fall term only.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

FSU will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language admissions requirement.

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance prior to admission into the program.
