Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required for admission; a minimum 3.0 GPA is required on all prerequisite courses with no grade lower than "C." The application deadlines are February 1 for Summer II (B) and March 1 for Fall admissions to both UF and Health Sciences. This means the university application, the department application, and all supporting information must be on file at UF by the deadline—not in the mail! Must have grades for prerequisite courses by end of Spring term. Also, volunteer work supervised by a registered occupational therapist is strongly recommended.

THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.
