

This Associate in Arts degree program is designed for students who expect to transfer and earn a bachelor's degree in Nursing at the University of Florida.

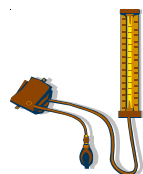

### Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A minimum GPA of 3.3 overall and in all pre-professional course work is required for consideration with no grade below "C". The nursing department application and all supporting materials must be RECEIVED by UF before March 1. All coursework must be completed by the end of the summer I semester prior to the anticipated fall registration (no more than two courses can be in progress during this term).

Admission is very competitive. To enhance your chances, select two of the following:

1. Engage in internships with government agencies, non-profit organizations, and businesses.
2. Engage in research with faculty.
3. Engage in volunteer service in the community.
4. Participate in overseas study.
5. Engage in leadership opportunities at UF.

The University of Florida will deny admission to any student who has not satisfied the state foreign language admissions requirement.
