

This Associate in Arts degree program has been designed for students who plan to transfer and earn a degree in Physical Education at Florida State University.

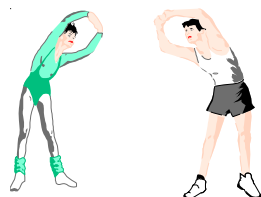
