Entrance Requirements

A minimum overall GPA of 3.0 is required for admission. Must have proof of current hepatitis B vaccination, current first aid CPR certification, and 100 hours of documented observation in athletic training. At time of application, student must also submit a letter confirming the specialization and outlining career goals. This program is highly competitive and the standards given are minimum standards. Transfer students who have met the tracking and minimum criteria must complete at least one full semester of the Clinical Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries at UF before their application to the program will be considered.
