### Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

In order to facilitate the admission of qualified students to the program, the department reviews applications submitted between **October 16 and March 15 for Fall Term** and between **March 16 and October 15 for the Spring Term for elementary education majors**. In addition to submitting an application to the Elementary Education program, students also need to submit an application for admission to the College of Education (available on the FSU website). All students are required to take and pass all sections of the CLAST exam or the General Knowledge portion of the FTCE before applying to the program. Students who meet all the requirements for admission and have a grade point average (GPA) greater than 3.0, an SAT score greater than 1070 or ACT greater than 22, an acceptable essay, and significant work experience with children will be admitted and notified by letter. The applications of students who otherwise meet all minimum admission requirements (2.5 GPA, passing all portions of the CLAST or General Knowledge portion of the FTCE, taking the SAT, and/or taking the ACT) will be held until the end of the application period. The admissions committee will consider all the information submitted in making admissions decisions. Although minimum scores for the SAT and/or ACT are not required for admission, information on test scores will be considered in addition to GPA, an acceptable essay, and a record of work with children. Applications of students who do not meet the minimum admission requirements set by the State of Florida for Teacher Education will be denied.

**FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.**

Applicants must be fingerprinted and pass a security clearance prior to admission into the program.
