

This Associate in Arts degree program is designed for students who expect to transfer and earn a bachelor's degree in Nursing at Florida State University.

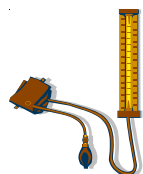

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program. Application deadlines are September 1 for the Spring term and February 1 for Fall term.

Students must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 and a minimum science GPA of 3.0. The minimum GPA of students accepted in the past few years has been about a 3.5 overall. Transfer students who have not earned the ADN and are not a licensed RN must take the HESI-A2 and score at least 75%. Students must be able to speak, read, and write English proficiently.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at Chipola to satisfy this requirement.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). NUR 3167 Research Process for Professional Nursing (required course) will satisfy this requirement.

Students must pass a criminal background check.

Attention: ADN to BSN students: FSU has upper division courses that will meet the speech requirement (NUR 4642) and the multicultural requirement (NUR 3655). Consider taking these two courses as a part of your 30 hours of upper division work for the BSN.

The Chipola courses which should meet this requirement at FSU include AMH 2091/2092, EDG 2701, GEA 2001/2002, REL 2300, SPT 2521, and SYG 1010. It is strongly recommended that one of these courses be completed before earning the AA degree. HSC 1531, Medical Terminology, may be taken as an elective. ADN students should consult with an advisor before taking HSC 1531; financial aid might be impacted.
